## NATIONAL LETTER OF INTENT REMINDERS

The NLI Early Signing Period for 09-10 is November 11-18. Please remember that a PSA remains a prospect following the signing of a National Letter of Intent. Thus, NLI signees should continue to be treated as prospects unless an exception applies.



### NLI Signing Rules:

- Coaches may make unlimited telephone calls to a PSA on the initial date for the NLI signing period and the two days immediately following that date.
- Beginning the day after the prospect signs the NLI, coaches may make unlimited contacts and phone calls to the signee. However, dead period restrictions continue to apply.
- The day after a PSA signs a NLI, there is no limit on electronic correspondence.
- A coach may not be present when a prospect signs an NLI off campus.

### NLI Delivery:

- A coach may not be present when a prospect signs an NLI off campus.
- In-person, off-campus delivery of a letter of intent by an institutional staff member is prohibited.
- A letter of intent may be delivered by express mail, courier service, regular mail, email or fax.
- The letter may be picked up by a PSA on an unofficial or official visit. They can also sign the letter while on campus, but no media can be present.

### NLI Publicity Regulations:

- Feel free to confirm with the media, sponsors or boosters that Sacramento State is recruiting a particular PSA prior to signing a letter of intent or written offer of admissions/financial aid.
- After the compliance office has confirmed a valid NLI/offer of aid has been received, feel free to comment on the PSA's athletic ability and contributions to your program.

### NLI/GIA Request Process:

- Submit the GIA Initial Request Form to the compliance office.
- If the PSA has not been evaluated by Josh Collins, you will need to also submit copies of transcripts and test scores for review.

## DEAD PERIOD REMINDERS

- It is impermissible to make in-person recruiting contacts or evaluations on or off the institution's campus.
- Coaches are not allowed to speak at banquets/events where PSA's are present.
- Recruiting phone calls may be made and recruiting correspondence may be sent during a dead period.
- No unofficial or official visits are allowed.

# November - Official Vacation Period/CARA Restrictions

17.1.6.2.1.1 - Sports Other than Championship Subdivision Football.

In sports other than championship subdivision football, a student-athlete may not participate in any countable athletically related activities outside the playing season during any institutional vacation period and/or summer. Strength and conditioning coaches who are not countable coaches and who perform such duties on a department-wide basis may design and conduct specific workout programs for student-athletes, provided such workouts are voluntary and conducted at the request of the student-athlete.

# NEW ADMISSIONS DEADLINES

**Don’t forget that there is a new admissions timeline in place for Fall 2010! Please be aware of these important dates and discuss these deadlines with PSA’s:**

**OCTOBER 1, 09 THROUGH NOVEMBER 30, 09 - Freshmen Priority filing period**

**MARCH 1, 2010 - Transfer Admissions application deadline**

**MARCH 1, 2010 - Admissions notifications begin being sent to applicants**

**MAY 1, 2010 - Last ELM/EPT test date**

**JUNE 30, 2010 - Document Deadline (test scores, transcripts, EPT/ELM scores)**

**JUNE/JULY - Mandatory Freshmen and Transfer Orientation**
