## **GAME NOTES**

#### **AROUND THE WAC**

Last weekend Sacramento State went 1-3 vs. San Jose State while New Mexico State took 3-of-4 in a non-conference road series at Seattle. In conference action, Louisiana Tech won three games in a four game series at home over Nevada. After Hawai'i took the first two games of the series, No. 16 ranked Fresno State rebounded to the win the final two and split the set. New Mexico State's Bryan Karraker earned WAC Hitter of the Week while Louisiana Tech's Caleb Dudley won the Pitcher of the Week honor. Karraker hit .636 (7-for-11) with seven runs scored and two RBI in the Aggies' series at Seattle.

#### **SANDOVAL'S TRANSITION TO STARTER**

Senior RHP Brandon Sandoval recorded a seveninning complete game shutout in a 2-0 victory over San Jose State on Saturday. Sandoval recorded four strikeouts to two walks and did not allow an extra base hit. With a pair of double plays behind him, Sandoval faced just two over the minimum in his best start of the season. Since making his first start of the season on April 3 at Seattle, Sandoval has a 1.97 ERA in 32 innings over five starts with four complete games. He has allowed just seven runs on 24 hits in that span.

#### **DEL GRANDE, YOUNG IN WAC GAMES**

In Sacramento State's 12 conference games this season, David Del Grande leads the team with a .349 batting average while Kirby Young is behind him with a .295 BA. Young leads the team with five RBIs while Blake Miller is a perfect 3-for-3 on stolen base attempts. Del Grande has 15 hits in 43 at-bats, including a team-best three doubles.

#### SUCCESS IN DOUBLEHEADERS

Sacramento State has posted a 7-3 record in the opening games of doubleheaders. The Hornets are 2-1 in the openers of WAC doubleheaders and won their most recent, 2-0, over San Jose State. The Hornets also defeated then-No. 12 Fresno State in the opening game of their doubleheader.

#### **HORNETS AGAINST NMSU PITCHERS**

Last year Sacramento State faced Ryan Beck, Tyler Mack and Dan Reid. The Hornets had no runs on five hits in 23 at-bats against Beck. Blake Miller went 2-for-3 and Andrew Ayers also had a hit. Sacramento State posted two runs on eight hits in 23 at-bats versus Mack. Kirby Young went 1-for-2 with two walks and Miller went 1-for-2. Dan Reid had similar success vs. the Hornets, allowing just two runs on seven hits in 25 at-bats. Jake Chilton is the only current player that had a hit against Reid. He went 1-for-3 and grounded into a double play.

#### **POSITION STARTERS IN FLUX**

First-year head coach has been searching for his best group of position starters all season. Because of that, each position has been manned by many different players. In the most recent switch, Kirby Young has been getting starts in centerfield with Blake Miller taking over at shortstop. Miller started 19 games at third base before moving to short for the first time against San Jose State on April 29. He was back at third in the first game of the doubleheader but played the final two games at short. Will Soto has been taking advantage of the switch, playing at third.

## HORNETS TAKE ONE FROM #12 FRESNO ST.

Sacramento State took a game from No. 12 ranked Fresno State last weekend. The Hornets won 2-1 in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader. In the seventh and final inning, Derrick Chung singled with the bases loaded to tie up the game 1-1 and then Kirby Young slapped a single up the middle to score the game-winning run. It was the Hornets' third walkoff win of the season and Young's second walk-off hit. Young also hit a walk-off single in the 10th inning to beat UC Davis, 3-2, on Feb. 21.

#### JOHN SMITH FIELD

Sacramento State's Hornet Field was renamed John Smith Field, in honor of long-time coach John Smith, who retired in 2010 after 32 seasons at the helm. Smith still works in the athletics department.

#### **PRESEASON NOTES**

#### YOUNG HORNETS IN THE DRAFT

The newest class of Hornets includes two high school players selected in the 2010 Major League Baseball draft. Shasta High School pitcher Dallas Chadwick was selected in the 18th round by the Boston Red Sox and Franklin High School pitcher Hunter Greenwood was selected in the 48th round by the Colorado Rockies). Chadwick, a 6-foot-3, 200-pound right-hander, went 9-2 in his senior season at Shasta with a 0.51 ERA and 22 hits allowed in 52.1 innings pitched. Chadwick tallied 113 strike outs compared to just 13 walks Greenwood, a 6-foot-2, 195-pound right-hander, helped lead Franklin High School to it's first ever playoff win. Greenwood went 6-2 in his senior season with a 3.46 ERA and had 26 walks and 55 strikeouts in 54.2 innings pitched.

#### WAC PRESEASON POLL/ALL-CONFERENCE

Fresno State has been selected as the favorite to win the 2011 Western Athletic Conference regular season baseball crown in a vote by the league's seven head coaches. The coaches also voted on a preseason all-WAC team with Fresno State leading the way as it placed seven players on the team. Hawai'i junior second baseman Kolten Wong was named the preseason player of the year, while SJSU senior Blake McFarland was picked the preseason pitcher of the year.

#### **HEAD COACH REGGIE CHRISTIANSEN**



EXPERIENCE: First Season RECORD: 15-31 (2-10 WAC) ALMA MATER: Menlo, 1998 HOMETOWN: Ferndale, Calif.

Reggie Christiansen begins his first season as the head baseball coach, taking over the reigns of the program after spending the last two seasons as an assistant and as the associate head coach.

Before coming to Sacramento State, Christiansen spent the previous four seasons (2005-08) as the head baseball coach at South Dakota State. He serves as the team's hitting instructor, recruiting coordinator and third base coach.

Christiansen was given the task of building a Division I baseball program during his four seasons with the Jackrabbits, taking over at the beginning of their reclassification period. Christiansen posted a 96-113 record at South Dakota State, turning a 12-win team in Division II a year previous to his hire in 2004 into a team that won the Division I Independent Tournament in 2007, collecting a 34-19 record. During that season, the Jacks notched wins in 11 states, ranging from California to Kentucky and Utah to North Dakota.

The 2007 Jackrabbits team reshaped the SDSU record books under Christiansen. The squad set records for runs scored (395), hits (573), doubles (99), total bases (891), runs batted in (357), and at bats (1,824). In addition, the 2007 team fielded .962, just one percentage point off the school mark. Christiansen earned Division I Independent Coach of the Year honors following that season.

Prior to his arrival at South Dakota State, Christiansen was an assistant at the University of Kansas under Ritch Price for two seasons. During his time with the Jayhawks, he served as first base coach and worked as a hitting instructor, while also overseeing the outfielders.

Under his tutelage, Kansas broke several school records and was honored by the Big 12 Conference. In 2004, Jayhawk hitters led the Big 12 with a .316 team batting average, the fourth highest in the program's history, while setting a school record with 697 hits. Kansas also shattered the school home run record during the Christiansen era.
