STANFORD, Calif. — Andrew Luck completed 17-of-23 passes for 316 yards and four touchdowns to lead Stanford to a 52-17 victory.

The Cardinal took a quick 14-0 lead with two long drives. The first used seven plays to cover 75 yards and was capped by a 1-yard run from Jeremy Stewart. The second ended with an 81-yard strike down the middle of the field from Luck to Doug Baldwin.

The Hornets cut the lead in half with 3:23 left the opening quarter when Kyle Monson took a punt at his own 30-yard line, made the first two defenders miss and dashed 70 yards up the right sideline for a TD. Monson became the first Sacramento State player to return a punt for a touchdown since Fred Amey against Saint Mary's on Sept. 6, 2003.

The Hornets showed their never-say-die attitude in the second half, coming out of the locker room to score a 2-yard touchdown on a run around the left end by Curtis Shaw. After Stanford matched the score, Chris Diniz connected on a career-long tying 52-yard field goal to make the score 45-17 with 11:56 to play in the game.

As a team, Sacramento State amassed 167 yards of total offense compared to 529 by the Cardinal. McLeod Bethel-Thompson completed 9-of-15 passes for 69 yards before exiting the game at halftime. Junior Jeff Fleming was 6-of-12 for 44 yards in the second half.

In the second half, Weber State pulled within four on an 11-yard pass from Higgins to Kam Kaimikaua. Chris Diniz added a 43-yard field goal early in the fourth to extend the lead back to seven.

Fleming finished the game 13-of-22 for 164 yards and two touchdowns without an interception. Deadder led the receiving corps with four grabs for 83 yards.

Defensively, Peter Buck tied for the game high with 11 stops. Marquese Smith added eight tackles and Dana Willis had seven.

As a team, Sacramento State outgained Weber State, 408-348. The biggest difference came on the ground where the Hornets outrushed the Wildcats (244-95).

MISSOULA, Mont. — In a game which featured eight lead changes, Montana quarterback Justin Roper completed 16-of-19 passes for 189 yards and two touchdowns, including the eventual game-winning 29-yard TD pass to Bryce Carver as the 14th-ranked Grizzlies knocked off Sacramento State, 28-25, at Washington-Grizzly Stadium.

Sacramento State forced four turnovers (three fumbles, one interception), controlled the time of possession (32:55-27:05) and out-gained Montana on the ground by a 139-40 margin, but could not score on any of its final three possessions. After a 3-yard touchdown pass from Jeff Fleming to Matt Carter gave the Hornets a 25-21 lead, Montana came up with a 12-play drive that featured a 4th-and-1, and three third-and-long conversions capped by a 29-yard touchdown pass to Carver with 9:34 left for a 28-25 lead.

Sacramento State kicker Chris Diniz connected on a program-record tying four field goals (50, 42, 28, 34). Hornet running back Bryan Hilliard, who had already rushed for 100 yards before halftime, finished with 124 yards on 26 carries.

Defensively, Sacramento State's Peter Buck (12) and Zach Schrader (11) both finished with double figures in tackles. Buck, Nash (two) and Dana Willis each forced a fumble while Willis also came up with his first career interception.

Defensively, the Hornets held Northern Colorado to just 238 yards of total offense and forced four turnovers. Sacramento State was particularly dominant in the second half, limiting the Bears to only 64 yards and five first downs while outscoring the NC 28-0 over the game's final 30 minutes.

FLAGSTAFF, Ariz. — Sacramento State jumped to a quick lead and never looked back as the Hornets marched to a 40-10 win over No. 25 Northern Arizona Saturday afternoon at the J.L. Walkup Skydome.

Bryan Hilliard scored the team's first two touchdowns while Jeff Fleming followed with a 10-yard TD pass to Ron Richardson before hitting Morris Norrise for scores of 39 and 12-yards.

In the first half, Fleming completed 20-24 passes for 247 yards and three touchdowns. Richardson caught a career-high eight passes in the half while Norrise has seven grabs for a career-best 93 yards.

Sacramento State backed off the accelerator in the second half, but not before stretching its lead to 40-0. NAU scored its first points on a 29-yard field goal from Drew Zamora with 9:49 remaining in the game. The final points came on a 65-yard fumble return.

As a team, Sacramento State compiled 488 yards while limiting the Lumberjacks to a season-low 166 yards on 55 plays. Fleming finished the game 23-of-32 for 333 yards and three TDs with one interception.

SACRAMENTO, Calif. — Behind three touchdown passes from Jeff Fleming, Sacramento State defeated Portland State, 28-15.

Sacramento State jumped to a 14-0 lead in the first quarter beginning with a 6-yard TD from Bryan Hilliard.

Morris Norrise extended the lead with a 43-yard catch from Fleming with 2:14 showing. On the play, Fleming faked a hand-off and a reverse before finding Norrise uncovered in the center of the field.

Zach Brown made the first of his three field goals with a 40-yard attempt early in the second quarter to put PSU on the board. Fleming answered with a 2-yard pass to tight end Matt Carter on the ensuing drive to push Sacramento State's lead to 21-3 with 8:45 left in the half.

Momentum swung in the favor of the Vikings when Cory McCaffrey rushed up the middle for a 5-yard touchdown. Following a defensive stop, Portland State drove the ball to the Sacramento State 11-yard line and faced a 3rd-and-3. However, Tygue Howland was called for intentional grounding resulting in a 20-yard loss and taking the team out of the red zone. The Vikings then attempted a pass on a fake field goal which fell incomplete.

PSU pulled within six, 21-15, on Brown's third make but the Hornets put the game away when Fleming hit Chase Deadder for a 57-yard touchdown on a post route midway through the fourth quarter.

The Hornets did most of their damage through the air with Fleming completing 13-of-23 passes for 240 and three scores.

Defensively, Peter Buck led all players with a season-high 15 total tackles, including seven solos.

DAVIS, Calif. — UC Davis' Sean Kelley's 21-yard field goal with 6:34 remaining proved to be the game winner as the Aggies defeated Sacramento State, 17-16, in the 57th-annual Causeway Classic at a rain-drenched Aggie Stadium.

Fighting monsoon-type conditions which featured 22-mile per hour winds, constant rain and a 35-minute lightening delay, both teams combined for just 377 yards. It was a game of field position in the second half as only three points were scored in a second half that featured 13 pass plays.

In fact, it was a muffed fair catch deep in Hornet territory by Sacramento State midway through the fourth quarter that set up the winning field goal. The Hornets lost three fumbles and threw an interception — resulting in all 17 of UC Davis' points.

Sacramento State opened the game on fire, scoring touchdowns on its first two drives to take a 13-0 lead with 4:58 remaining in the first half. The Hornets scored on the first drive of the game, converting on a 4th-and-1 from the 1-yard line as Jeff Fleming completed a jump pass to tight end Matt Carter in the back of the end zone.

After forcing a three-and-out on UC Davis' first drive, Sacramento State's Zach Schrader blocked an Aggie punt and set up the Hornets on the 20-yard line. Six plays later, Fleming found Chase Deadder from four yards out to put Sacramento State up, 13-0.

Anthony Soto hauled in two touchdown passes to give the Aggies a 14-13 lead late in the second quarter before Chris Diniz made a 30-yard field goal as time expired.

During the break, lighting forced the field and the stadium to be evacuated. The 35-minute delay combined with the 22-minute halftime and warmups, kept both teams off the field for over an hour.
