Big Sky Leaders

As a team ISU is first in kickoff return average at 24 yards a return and first in punt return average at 18.1 yards. As a team ISU ranks second in net punting at 37.1 yards a kick. Brendon Garcia is one of only two kickers in the Big Sky to make every extra point. David Harrington ranks first in punting with an average of 44.6 yards a kick and Tavoy Moore is first in punt return average at 26.2 yards and second in all-purpose yards at 193.9 yards a game. A.J. Storms is first in the conference in tackles at 12.8 while Chris Holmesly is third at 9.9 and Basim Hudeen at 9.2. Sean Rutten is fourth in sacks per game at .56 as he currently has five. Chris Holmesly is second in forced fumbles with four.

It's a First

Tavoy Moore became the first Big Sky football player in conference history to return a kickoff and punt return for touchdowns in two different games. He accomplished this feat at Northern Colorado and Montana.

Born: February 13, 1956 (Tacoma, Wash.)

Hometown: Tacoma, Wash.

Family: He and his wife of 10 years Mary Ellen have four children: Megan (25), Kyle (21), Kenny (11), and Kasey (9).

College: Pacific Lutheran, 1979 - Earned his degree in physical education and eventually became a fifth round draft choice of the New England Patriots.

Playing Experience: Zamberlin played linebacker in the NFL for six seasons, playing 78 total games with the New England Patriots (1979-1982) and the Kansas City Chiefs (1983-1984). While with New England, he recorded one career interception, a fumble recovery, and he recovered a blocked kick against the New York Jets, and his lateral on that play led to a 56-yard touchdown, only the second blocked field goal return for a touchdown in Patriots history. He was also drafted in baseball by the Seattle Mariners after a standout collegiate career as a centerfielder.

Bengals A Top NCAA Stats

A.J. Storms returned to the top of the NCAA leaderboard in tackles per game after his 16 tackles at Georgia. He is averaging 12.8 tackles a game. David Harrington is second in the nation in punting at 44.6 yards a kick. Tavoy Moore is second in punting return average at 26.17 yards a return and third in all-purpose yards at 193.89. As a team, Idaho State ranks No. 2 in punt return average at 18.13 and 12th in kickoff return average at 24.04.

Longest Drive

Against Montana State, Idaho State recorded it's longest scoring drive since playing at Weber State on Sept. 19, 2009 (nine play, 84 yard drive). ISU's opening score was a nine play, 83 yard drive that took 3:40 and resulted in the first touchdown of the game against the Bobcats. Below are ISU's longest scoring drives of the season.

Tew The House

Dustin Tew's 100-yard interception return for a touchdown against Weber State on Oct. 16 was only the second time this season an FCS player has returned an interception return 100-yards for a touchdown. That mark also tied the school record for longest interception return for a touchdown.

Moore Closing in on Big Sky Records

Tavoy Moore's 100-yard kickoff return at Montana brings him within one kickoff return for a touchdown from tying the single-season Big Sky Record. Moore is one of only two players in the FCS to return a 100-yard kickoff return for a touchdown this season. Bashir Livingston returned three kicks to the end zone in 1998. Moore needs two more kick returns for a touchdown to tie the Big Sky single-season record for most touchdowns scored on via a kickoff or punt. In 2003, Montana State's Corey Smith had four punt returns and two kickoff returns for touchdowns while Livingston had three kickoffs and three punt returns for touchdowns in 1998 – the single season conference record. Moore currently has two kickoff and two punt returns for touchdowns.

Defense to Offense

Due to injuries, several Bengal players have made the move from defense to offense. Phil Pleasant started the year as a defensive back and is now playing running back. Jake Hutton was moved from linebacker to running back, David Tyler was moved from the defensive line to the offensive line, Leki Fuapau was moved from linebacker to tight end and JT Albers started the year at linebacker and was moved to full back.

Moore Breaks Own School Record

Tavoy Moore broke his own school record for most all-purpose yards in a game as he had 323 at Montana on Oct. 9. He previously set the school record with 318 at Northern Colorado. His performance earned him Kickoff and Punt Returner National Player of the Week honors by Collegefootballperformance awards.com, his second of the season. Against Montana, Moore became only the third Bengal to return a kickoff 100 yards for a touchdown. Prior to Moore the last ISU player to return a kickoff 100 yards was JD Ponciano at Montana in 2007. Moore also returned an 84-yard punt return for a touchdown. Moore caught two passes for 28 yards and carried the ball one time for eight yards. For the game Moore had 195 kickoff return yards and 92 yards in punt returns. ISU's school single-season record for kickoff return average is 33.0 by Carlis Harris (22 returns for 726 yards) in 1969 and Moore is averaging 28 yards a kickoff return. He is

averaging 27.2 yards returning punts. Carlis Harris also holds ISU's single-season record for punt return average, 22.8 (11 for 251 yards) in 1970. A scary thought-- Moore had another punt return for a touchdown vs. UNC called back by offsetting penalties. ISU's single-season school record for all-purpose yards is 192.1 yards per game by ISU Sports Hall of Fame member Merrill Hoge in 1985 and Moore is currently averaging 193.89 yards a game.

Kicking Long

ISU redshirt freshman kicker Brendon Garcia kicked his second 50-yard field goal of the season at Portland State. He is a perfect two-for-two from beyond 50. His two 50-yard field goals ties for the 13th best field goal kicks this season out of all the FCS schools. The longest field goal made this season is 55-yards.

Harrington Punting Power

David Harrington continues to lead the Big Sky Conference in punting with an average of 44.6 yards a kick. He received FCS Honorable Mention Performance of the Week for punters for his play against Northern Arizona; his second of the season. After averaging 45.3 yards on four punts against Northern Colorado he averaged 48.6 yards on seven punts against Northern Arizona on Sept. 25. He had previously averaged 45.7 vs. Montana Western and 46.7 at Utah State.

Hill Inching Higher in Record Books

Russel Hill continues to inch his way closer to the ISU career history in all three passing categories. Hill is second in school history in pass attempts, pass completions and passing yardage. He is even closer to overtaking current record holder, Jason Whitmer (1987-90). Whitmer owns the pass attempts title with 1,349 while Hill has 1,107. Whitmer has a record 721 pass completions, Hill has 634 and Whitmer has 9,081 passing yards while Hill has 7,123. Hill is also sixth all-time for ISU in touchdown passes with 41. Whitmer owns the title with 55.

Storms Top Tackler

Junior linebacker A.J. Storms continues to lead the team in tackles for the season. He currently has 115 with 50 of the tackles being unassisted. Storms leads the Big Sky and nation in tackles per game with 12.8. The 20 tackles he had at Utah State and Montana puts Storms tied for fourth for most tackles in an FCS game this year.

Sacked

Senior defensive end Sean Rutten recorded four quarterback sacks vs. Northern Colorado, his first sacks since 2008, for losses of 37 yards. ISU had only eight sacks all last year, but nailed UNC's quarterback six times. Rutten approached the ISU one-game record of 5.5, which the school's all-time sack leader Josh Hays inflicted on Boise State in 1994. As a team, ISU has 10 sacks this year. He also recorded a sack at Georgia, giving him five on the year.
