HEAD COACH BRIAN KATZ



Brian Katz begins his first year as head coach of the Sacramento State men's basketball program. He became the 13th men's basketball coach in school history when he was named to the position by Director of Athletics Terry Wanless on April 10, 2008.

A graduate of Sacramento State and a native of Sacramento, Katz's extensive basketball resumé includes a 32-year career as a basketball coach at the NCAA Div. I, junior college and high school levels.

Over the last 19 years – all as a junior college head coach – Katz compiled a 435-185 record (.702 winning percentage) while leading his teams to the playoffs 18 times, including three Sweet 16 appearances, three Elite 8 appearances and one trip to the Final Four. Also during that 19-year span, his teams combined for seven conference championships and he received conference coach of the year accolades seven times.

For his efforts, Katz will be inducted into the California Community College Men's Basketball Coaches Association Hall of Fame in Fresno on March 13, 2009.

He spent the past 15 seasons (1993-2008) as head coach at San Joaquin Delta College in Stockton, where he posted a 348-138 record (.716 winning percentage) and led the team to 14 playoff appearances, six conference championships, two Elite Eight appearances, and one Final Four appearance.

A six-time conference coach of the year at Delta College, Katz guided the team to three conference championships over the last five years and a 130-32 record over that span.

Prior to his tenure at Delta College, Katz spent four years (1989-93) at Lassen College in Susanville, Calif., where he led the team to an 87-47 record, four playoff appearances and a league championship. One of those playoff appearances came in 1992 when he guided the team to the Elite Eight despite the school having just 800 students.

In addition, during Katz's junior college head coaching tenure, of the 115 players that finished their sophomore years under his tutelage, 109 of them advanced to four-year institutions – 66 on scholarships.

Before entering the junior college head coaching ranks, Katz was an assistant under Carroll Williams at Santa Clara where the team combined for a 40-22 overall record and reached the NIT both seasons during his two-year stay (1987-89).

Previous to his stint with Santa Clara, Katz was the head coach at Antelope's Center High School (1983-87) where he led the team to a four-year combined record of 53-34, including three Sac-Joaquin Section playoff appearances and one league championship. He began his head coaching career at the age of 23 as the varsity coach at Orangevale's Casa Roble High School in 1982.

The 50-year old Katz also spent time at Sylvan Middle School (Citrus Heights, Calif.), and as an assistant at Mesa Verde High School, Casa Roble High School and Grant High School prior to getting his first head coaching stint at Casa Roble.

Katz earned his bachelor's degree in English from Sacramento State in 1980, and his master's degree in counseling psychology from Santa Clara in 1989.

Katz and his wife, Lori, have five children – Katie (20), Vinny (19), Megan (18), Steven (17) and Jimmy (12).

GAME PREVIEW

With just five games remaining in the regular season, Sacramento State embarks upon its final homestand of the season...the Hornets (2-22, 1-10) begin the two-game homestand on Thursday, Feb. 12, when the team hosts Montana (14-9, 8-3) at 7:05 p.m... one lucky fan will have the opportunity to make a halfcourt shot and win a new Pontiac Vibe at halftime...although the Hornets are 2-9 at home this season, the team's last three games inside the friendly confines have been decided by eight points or less...the team had a legitimate chance of winning all three of those games, but the only win during that stretch came against Idaho State on Jan. 24 (72-69)...Thursday's game is a big one for Montana as the team is trying to secure one of the top two seeds in the Big Sky Tournament and a subsequent bye in the first round...the Grizzlies are tied for second with Portland State with an 8-3 conference record, two games behind first-place Weber State (9-1)...Montana defeated Sacramento State earlier this season in Missoula by the score of 80-63 (box on pg. 16), and now own a 25-5 all-time record against the Hornets.... however, the Hornets have won three of the last five meetings between the two teams in Sacramento...Thursday's game can be seen live and free via webcast at www.bigskytv.org...the contest can be heard live on KRJY 1240 AM, and on the internet at www.hornetsports.com with play-by-play announcer Steve McElroy calling the action.

A LOOK AT THE LAST GAME

In a game that featured a combined 101 points and just 33 made field goals, Portland State took advantage of 10 three-pointers to eventually defeat Sacramento State, 59-42, last Sunday at the Stott Center. Both teams combined to shoot just 33.7 percent (33-for-98) and no player on either team scored more than 11 points.

Portland State used a 22-4 run spanning 9:43 of the first half to take a 30-12 lead with 2:11 remaining in the first stanza. During the run, five different Vikings combined to bury six three-pointers while the Hornets shot just 2-of-13, including seven consecutive missed field goal attempts at one point during the spurt.

The 22-4 run proved to be the difference in the game as Portland State eventually defeated Sacramento State by a 17-point spread. Neither team shot particularly well during the contest (Vikings shot 34.0 percent, Hornets shot 33.3 percent), and a big disparity in the game came at the three-point line where Portland State made 10-of-29 from beyond the arc compared to just 1-of-9 for Sac State.

Sacramento State's defense limited Portland State to its second lowest scoring output of the season (59), and the Vikings converted on just two of their final 18 field goal attempts spanning the final 12:16 of the game. However, after the 22-4 spurt by Portland State in the first half, Sacramento State got no closer than within 14 points of the Vikings' lead the rest of the afternoon.

Portland State's Kyle Coston's 11 points were the most scored in the game, and the Vikings' Julius Thomas added 10 points and 10 rebounds. Dominic Waters added nine points and Jeremiah Dominguez finished with eight for a Portland State team which used the three ball to account for over half (30) of the team's final tally of 59 points.

Sacramento State was led by junior Justin Eller's 10 points and eight rebounds in a team-best 32 minutes. Senior Loren Leath added 10 points and senior Randy Adams finished with five points and eight rebounds (six of those boards came in the first half). Flaggs had seven points and five other Hornets each contributed two points apiece. The Hornets finished the game shooting 33.3 percent (16-48) from the field, 11.1 percent (1-9) from the three-point line and 60.0 percent (9-15) from the free throw line.

**RARELY A SINGLE-DIGIT GAME**

Through the first 24 games of the season, Sacramento State has played in just three games that have been decided by single digits. Every other game, including the first 19 of the year, have been decided by 10 points or more. Each of the three single-digit games came in succession (and at home) against Weber State (L, 67-59), Idaho State (W, 72-69) and Northern Colorado (L, 66-59), respectively. In fact, the Hornets could have easily gone 3-0 during that stretch from Jan. 22-29. In the losses to Weber State and Northern Colorado, the Hornets fell victim to late 8-0 runs by both the Wildcats and Bears.

**SHOOTING IT LONG RANGE**

Although Sacramento State is averaging a league-low 58.0 points per game, the Hornets have been proficient from beyond the three-point line. The team is now third in the conference (and 47th in the nation) with a .377 three-point field goal percentage (130-345). If the season ended today, the .377 percentage would easily rank as the top mark since the program joined the Div. I ranks in 1991-92. The team has buried at least 40.0 percent of its three-point attempts in five of the last seven games. The Hornets have three players shooting better than 42.0 percent from beyond the arc, comprised of Jonathan Malloy (.462), Jared Stigall (.429) and Antonio Flaggs (.427). That doesn't even include Loren Leath, who is shooting 38.6 percent from the arc while ranking second in the league with 2.3 treys per game.

**TWENTY-FOUR GAMES, SIXTEEN STARTING LINEUPS**

Through 24 games, head coach Brian Katz has used 16 different starting lineups (see page 8 for a complete list). Of the 12 eligible players on the roster, 11 have started at least one game, and no player has started more than 22 games. The lineup used most often this year (five times), including the team's last game at Portland State, consists of guards Jared Stigall, Antonio Flaggs and Loren Leath, forward Justin Eller and center Randy Adams. Those five players also happen to average five of the top six minutes per game marks on the team. The only player on the roster yet to start a game is sophomore Aaron Wilson who had missed seven straight games with an Achilles injury before playing the last two games.

**WHO'S OUT?**

Walk-ons Stephen Calton and Mike Edwards were deemed ineligible prior to the Northern Arizona game, and will miss the remainder of the season. In addition, junior Aj Kapanoske broke his foot one day before the season began and will not play this year. Junior Domineek Daniel is ineligible to play this season, and sophomore Aaron Wilson had missed seven consecutive games with an Achilles injury before returning to play sparingly the last two games.

**428 AND COUNTING**

Sacramento State has made at least one three-pointer in 428 straight games, a streak which dates back 16 years. The last time the Hornets did not make a three-pointer came on Nov. 28, 1993, when the team went 0-for-6 in an 85-57 loss at Montana State.

**THE DREADED DROUGHTS**

In nearly every loss this season, the Hornets have fallen victim to long droughts which has allowed the opposition to take control of the game. Some of the opponent runs have effectively taken the Hornets completely out of the game. Below is the most substantial opponent run from each loss this season and the duration of each of those spurts.

**NOT MISTAKE PRONE**

Despite combining for seven turnovers and just one assist over his last two games, junior Jared Stigall has been far from error prone this season. In fact, the Sacramento native has 49 assists compared to just 22 turnovers. If he had enough assists to qualify, Stigall would rank first in the Big Sky with a 2.2-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio. Easily the quickest player on the team, Stigall has turned the ball over two times or less in all but one game this season. Moreover, he went the first nine games and 131 minutes without committing a turnover before his first miscue of the season came at the 9:46 mark of the first half against Wyoming.

**LEATH'S MONSTER NIGHT HIGHLIGHTS BIG SEASON**

Including a Sacramento State Div. I (1991-pres.) record 41 points and nine three-pointers at Northern Colorado on Jan. 13, senior shooting guard Loren Leath has scored in double figures in all but five games this season. He is now third in the Big Sky with an average of 15.9 points per game. Against Big Sky competition, Leath has been even more impressive. In 11 conference games, Leath is first in three-point field goal percentage (.467), and second in both scoring (18.6 points per game) and three-pointers (2.6 per game).

He has scored in double figures 19 times this year and 71 times during his four seasons in the Green and Gold. After missing the first three games of his freshman season due to injury, Leath has played in 108 straight games, and over that time, easily leads the program with 24 games scoring at least 20 points.

**ELLER MAKING A BIGGER IMPACT**

Sacramento State had gone nearly two years without a player registering a double-double, but junior Justin Eller ended that streak and now has four this season. He registered his fourth against Idaho State when he had 12 points and 12 rebounds. His average of 6.8 rebounds per game is the third best mark in the Big Sky, just 0.3 boards behind first-place Divaldo Mbunga of Montana State (7.1).

Eller has led or tied for the team lead in rebounding in 16 games, and has secured at least five rebounds in all but five games this year. In addition, after scoring in double figures twice all of last year, he has posted double-figure points 14 times this season. This year's averages of 10.2 points, 6.8 rebounds and a team-best 29.7 minutes per game dwarfs last season's numbers (4.8 points, 3.5 rebounds and 18.4 minutes per game).

**ROSTER LOADED WITH JC TRANSFERS**

According to Luke Winn of Sports Illustrated, Sacramento State's roster contains, by far, the most junior college transfers among the 347 Div. I men's basketball teams. Of the 16 players on the Hornets' roster, 15 came to the program via the junior college ranks. The closest teams to Sacramento State in terms of junior college transfers on the roster are Texas-San Antonio (11) and Arkansas State (10).

The Hornets brought in 12 new players this season, each of which being junior college transfers. Added to the four returners (three of which were JC transfers, one came from a prep school), the Hornets' roster is almost exclusively made up of players who attended junior college. In fact, Sacramento State is believed to also be the only Div. I school in the nation that does not have one player that came directly from high school.

During this year's early signing period, the team inked 6-9, 280-pound center Dani Lopez of South Elgin High School during this year's early signing period.

**HORNET NOTABLES**

Either Loren Leath or Justin Eller has led the Hornets in scoring in 14 straight games, and in 21 games overall this year...among Big Sky leaders, junior shooting guard Antonio Flaggs is second in free throw percentage (.855) and sixth in three-point field goal percentage (.427), but is converting on just 27.3 percent (18-66) of his field goal attempts from inside the three-point arc...senior center Randy Adams, who has started 14 of the last 17 games, is averaging 9.7 points and 4.9 rebounds on 50.0 percent shooting from the field (25-50) over his last seven games...junior point guard (and team co-captain) Mike Marcial's four points last Thursday at Eastern Washington was tied for his second-highest output of the season. Marcial, who averages 1.5 points and 18.8 minutes, attempts just one field goal every 11.9 minutes of playing time...the Hornets' Loren Leath (15.9), Justin Eller (10.2), Antonio Flaggs (8.1) and Randy Adams (7.5) combine to average 41.7 of the team's average of 58.0 points per game.
