Directions to Granite Regional Park

Eastbound: Take I-80 East to US-50 East; Exit Howe Avenue/Power Inn Rd; Go right onto Howe Ave/Power Inn Rd; Make a left at the third light – Cucamonga Ave and follow the road into the park.

Westbound: Take 1-80 West to Bus-80/99 South to US-50 East; Exit Howe Avenue/Power Inn Rd; Go right onto Howe Ave/Power Inn Rd; Make a left at the third light – Cucamonga Ave and follow the road into the park.

Northbound: Take US-99 or I-5 North to Sacramento; Take US-50 East; Exit Howe Avenue/Power Inn Rd; Go right onto Howe Ave/Power Inn Rd; Make a left at the third light – Cucamonga Ave and follow the road into the park.
